SpamAssassin marks the email header with a tag; how the other filters (i.e Blacklist,DNSBL) mark spam email when their spam action policy is set to "accept/deliver (marked as junk)". Do they add a tag to email headers?Is there any way to distinguish email marked as junk from these filters?
