I have written some new company specific rules for spamassissan (No Spam Today!). Before option.

```
C:\XXX\sa>C:\XXX\sa\spamassassin -d --configpath=C:\XXX\sa --prefspath
C:\XXX\sa\ruleset\local.cf --siteconfigpath=C:\XXX\sa\ruleset\ --lint
```

That worked fine and I could find some syntax errors, except the fact that I get two error messages that I can not explain nor correct:

Use of uninitialized value in concatenation (.) or string at /PerlApp/File/Spec Win32.pm line 240.

Use of uninitialized value in open at /PerlApp/Mail/SpamAssassin/TextCat.pm line 63.

cannot open languages: No such file or directory
