Hello,

Is it possible to create a rule that marks e-mails sent from domain Y always as NON spam IF sent to domain X?

What I've done so far is creating the following rule in local.cf file:

```
#domainX
header DOMAIN_TRUSTED_TO To =~ /domainX\.com/i header DOMAIN_TRUSTED_FROM
From =~ /domainY\.com/i meta domainX_CUSTOM (DOMAIN_TRUSTED_TO &&
DOMAIN_TRUSTED_FROM) score domainX_CUSTOM -8
```

but it doesn't work.

The score of such mails is calculated as follows:

0.2 NO\_REAL\_NAME From: does not include a real name

0.6 J\_CHICKENPOX\_21 BODY: 2alpha-pock-1alpha

0.6 J\_CHICKENPOX\_62 BODY: 6alpha-pock-2alpha

0.6 J\_CHICKENPOX\_63 BODY: 6alpha-pock-3alpha

0.6 J\_CHICKENPOX\_65 BODY: 6alpha-pock-5alpha -0.0 BAYES\_44 BODY: Bayesian spam probability is 44 to 50%
