I've been looking at attempting to use at least one of these plugins for SpamAssassin, but have found very little support for them on the Windows platform. Razor2 seems the worst; to run it on Windows you either have to use a for-pay 3rd part app, or run SpamAssassin, et. al., in Cygwin.

Pyzor does have a Windows port, and even has instructions on the official SpamAssassin Wiki. (<http://wiki.apache.org/spamassassin/UsingPyzor>) However, it is a bit complicated and convoluted, and I hate to get too involved in it without knowing if it can be done. :) Has anyone tried it and failed, or tried and succeeded? My buddies who run Linux mail servers tell me that Razor and Pyzor are miracle workers in filtering, so I really want to try at least one of them.
