Every day at midnite, I recive this "dayle email stats" email from my NoSpamToday installation, which has a 25 users licence.

It looks something like this :

Mail Statistics (Since Last Report):

spam mail:	549 (17.6%)
legitimate mail:	2578 (82.4%)
unchecked (exceeding max. mail size):	4
unchecked (spam check disabled):	1714
unchecked (error):	0
total no. of mails received:	4845

I was wondering, what does the "unchecked (spam check disabled)" mean ? Where does that come from - I have only used 23 og 25 email addresses, so I cannot come from skipping email addresses in the spam check.
