Subject: Multiple recipients

Symptoms:

My NST Proxy attachment filter is configured to filter (reject/delete) a specific list of recipient addresses. The problem is, that if an incoming mail is addressed to multiple recipients (e.g. \*@mydomain.com) and if there's at least one non-existing address within the recipients which is not filtered (Log: check disabled), the mail is delivered to the existing mailboxes regardless of a malicious attachment! Because of the (non-existing) recipient which is not listed in the 'address patterns to enable filter' the check is disabled and the mail is delivered.

How can I prevent this behaviour?
