I'm getting an error stating: "No configuration text or files found! Please check your setup." when I run the bat file that I've written to run sa-learn. This is running on a Windows 2003 server with Exchange 2003. I'm using Thunderbird as a client.

I get the spam using Thunderbird and then run this bat file:

```
cd "\program files\No Spam Today!"  
sa\s-a-learn -C sa\myrules.cf --spam c:/inbox
```

The reason I don't have an ".mbx" after c:/inbox is that the Thunderbird client doesn't put this extension on the file. Am I doing this correctly?

Please disregard, I was able to correct the problem. I was trying to do an sa-learn on a folder using a single message switch. I changed my bat file to the following and it works fine now.

```
sa\s-a-learn -C sa\ruleset --spam --mbox C:/NoSpam
```
