message score, if PAD is included and is either spaces or zeroes, then pad scores with that many spaces or zeroes (default, none) ie: `_SCORE(0)_` makes 2.4 become 02.4, `_SCORE(00)_` is 002.4. 12.3 would be 12.3 and 012.3 respectively.
