The problem is, it simply reduces the message scoring by a small amount. I want Spam Assassin to not filter messages FROM these users AT ALL. How can I do that? I want it to simply route the message onward without filtering it at all if it originates from a user defined in the whitelist_from

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The easiest way is to use NST, configuration, Spamassassin, click advanced options, then uncheck the "Use Same Address Settings as Previous Filter" and add the e-mail addresses that you want on a permanent white list into the box "Address patterns to disable filter".

Remember that if you have any other NST filters following the SpamAssassin filter - they will adopt the same rules as you have just setup.

The entries on a white list are given -100 points.... which should mean that they will always make it through EVEN if they are spam.
