sa-learn --spam "m:\westwoodcompanies.com\public folders>false negatives"
```

Then I get.

No configuration text or files found! Please check your setup.

No such file or directory.

I have read both the 'how to train and maintain the bayes database' and the 'sa-learn - train spamassassin's bayesian classifier' documents.

I can not figure out the correct PATH for the sa-learn command.

I am running a Windows 2000 Exchange Server and the False Negatives IS a public folder where I am storing the unreported spam messages.
