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I have made the following settings in the local.cf file:

but when i get an email through in the header it says the following:

so why does it not say:

```
X-Spam-Status: No, hits=0.0 required=5.0 tests=none autolearn=yes version=2.63
```

Please note that the mail in question got a score of 0.0 (hits=0.0, tests=none) and thus does not get auto-learned.

SpamAssassin requires at least 3 points from the header and 3 points from the body to auto-learn as spam. If either section contributes fewer points, the message will not be auto-learned.
