Is the file in mbox format? If this is the case, run: cd [NoSpamTodayInstallationPath] sa\sa-learn -c sa\ruleset --spam --mbox "[FolderPath]"

Otherwise:

cd [NoSpamTodayInstallationPath] sa\sa-learn -c sa\ruleset --spam "MessageFile"
