Is the file in mbox format ? If this is the case, run:

```
cd [NoSpamTodayInstallationPath]
```

```
sa\sas-learn -c sa\ruleset --spam --mbox "[FolderPath]"
```

Otherwise:

```
cd [NoSpamTodayInstallationPath]
```

```
sa\sas-learn -c sa\ruleset --spam "MessageFile"
```
