NST just seems a great tool but greatly lacking in sooo many areas to become a viable product for us to use and to tout to others - and it's not the functionality of the core engine, as that is tracking and blocking SPAM like nobody's business, it's the fluff around the edges - maintenance of the system (apart from a wizard with about 20 fields on about 5 pages), live logging, setup of the engine to tweak and tune it to suit a client's environment (for instance, to allow shouting for customers who are principally Asian suppliers to one of our clients ... I'm gonna have to read half the SPAMAssassin's website, which to be honest, if I was a true geek, I'm sure it would make a lot more sense, but I neither know Linux nor Unix (apart from Uni many many years ago!) even though I'm on the PC stupid hours per day, so most of it goes straight over my head!

I'm not asking for a re-write of the system, I'm just looking for pointers - we can do all the rest of the work here ourselves. I guess the real support team put their hours in to paying customers, but then it's a catch 22 ... if I don't see that support have the answers or the tool is up to the job, I'm not going to dig into the pocket!

I have guys here, including myself, who are willing to put the hours in to make this product work

for us, which will mean a full turnkey solution to sell NST onto Lotus Notes/Domino houses.
