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This is similar to what I'm experiencing, but my mail definitely goes to NST. All emails have the NST info in their headers; they just don't always have the X-Spam info. ( see post at <http://www.byteplant.com/forum/read.php?f=1&i=244&t=244> ) It seems very sporadic with some incoming mail containing X-Spam info and some does not. I haven't found any consistency to it. One email recipient can receive 1 or 2 spam-checked message and 7 or 8 non-checked messages; only about 10% or so is actually getting spam checked and even less is getting flagged.

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
