The system load is calculated from the system RAM usage. SpamAssassin or virus checkers use a lot of system RAM, and NoSpamToday! takes pains not to drive the server into saturation.

> I'm looking at a sys load of 32%, with 10 active sessions,
> but I look at my task manager and see a consisten 3% CPU usage
> flicker on task manager as it processes mails, I guess, and
> 7.5meg RAM usage.

While NoSpamToday! uses only 7.5MB, there still may be virus checkers or SpamAssassin instances around that use about 25MB each.
