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Not to worry, it is just that SpamAssassin does not look at this mail any more, because it is too large.

You can increase the skip size (check "advanced options" at the start of the SpamAssassin filter configuration dialog), but you shouldn't.

SpamAssassin resource usage grows exponentially with message size, and it is recommended to check no mails larger than 256k.
