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Most of our servers are based on Qmail, which does not accept the bare lf generated by mails sent from No Spam SMTP proxy.

When I use the Test option from Global Settings to any of my qmail servers, I get an error thrown by qmail which directs you to <http://smtpd.developer.com/barelf.html>

As per the URL, this is due to NST SMTP Proxy not following 822bis section 2.3, which specifically prohibits all bare LFs.

Any fixes on this?
