Yes.

The config option you want can be changed directly in the config file (nospamtoday.cf). Find a section named [...\MonitoringPort] and add a line like this:

```
IncomingServer="10.0.0.12"
```

Now, the NoSpamToday! service listens on the 10.0.0.12 interface for monitoring connections.

Now, copy the nospamtoday.cf file to the client machine (to the same directory where you put the admin program. Here, you need to add this line to the MonitoringPort section of the config file:

```
OutgoingServer="10.0.0.12"
```

Use any servicable text editor to do this.

This would even work over the Internet, but you shouldn't open the monitoring port to the outside world without some safeguards in your firewall (i.e. allow connections only from certain hosts).
