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You could move the spam filter check in front of the anti-virus check. That would act as you have requested. (as you apparently have done) If identified as spam you should be able to set the filter to reject-delete and it would not be checked by the anti-virus software.

But there are reasons for checking before doing the spam check. One is that some of the ant-virus programs (CLAM-AV for example) can follow URL's in the e-mail and detect phishing and links to trojan sites. This stops the mail before even spam checking it.

Also there is always a concern that at some point in time a hacker exploit might be created for spamassassin that allows the remote execution by a virus or worm. Not likely to happen - but checking the e-mail with anti-virus software first significantly reduces that possibility of that happening.
