sender(s) to the whitelist does not really help much because spamassassin does not get bypassed.

If you want to whitelist a sender would it not be more efficient to completely bypass spamassassin, or at least have this as an option? Ideally there would be an option to enable and disable a filter based on sender, similar to that for recipients. Is it likely that this feature will get included in a future release?
