"rejected due to policy reason" is quite common, so the sender is not able to recognize, that his mail's too large.

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Unfortunately that's not reported in any log. So i don't know. (Only the sender's getting the message)

But we had other cases, similar failure messages like this:

Nov 02, 2006, 14:09:59 Session 4: (McAfee Antivirus) Buffer size exceeds limit

in this case the sender was getting a 550 error, and he was quiet confused. (me too)

He said the mail was small. Maybe something else is responsible for the buffer size errors.

So i doubled the buffer size to let the mail server behind reject mails that are too large.

Now we have to look whether "buffer size" messages are still appearing.

In my opinion the Mail size should be checked first and eg. if a mail's larger than 20MB it has to be rejected with a "mail too large" message without processing any filters anymore.
