> Is this possible?

If you choose "reject/delete" as the policy for SpamAssassin, the message is deleted and never read back by NST to check and log the score.

A change of this behavior is already on our wish list and will be included in one of the upcoming releases.

To force NST to log the score, there is a trick you can use. Set the filtering policy to accept/deliver, and set the delete threshold to same value as your required score.
