> What may cause this?

This happens when the operating system returns an WSAENOBUFFS (10055) error. This can happen for a number of reasons, depending on the Windows version and service pack you use.

There are several web pages and MS knowledge base articles dedicated to this error message, just google WSAENOBUFFS to get started.
