NST is doing an amazing job of cleansing our incoming mail, but there's one type of message that is consistently getting through and the volume of these messages is growing recently.. basically, it's a "check out this hot new stock" message with an inline image within the message -- the image has a grainy background pattern always with the details of the stock, and the body (possibly just the plaintext part) of the message has random paragraphs of text.

Any thoughts on ways to spot these? The new Image Plugin sounds interesting, but I think that may just be a way to identify messages with numbers or sizes of images.
